#### Methodology

- The objectives of the Toronto Star/La Presse/EKOS Federal Election 2005-06 nightly polling are two-fold:
  - i. first, to create a large, reliable weekly sample, modeling voter intention and the driving factors, including the day-to-day trends (reported on Saturdays); and
  - second, to provide the most immediate and focused summary of national voting intentions (reported on a daily basis).
- This document presents the daily findings from telephone surveys with a national random sample of Canadians, 18 years of age and older conducted between January 7 and 9, 2006.
  - Daily sample sizes and associated margins of error are presented on the next page.
  - Please note that the margin of error increases when the results are sub-divided.
  - Refusal rate and measurement errors will also increase the overall survey error.




Q: If a federal election were held tomorrow, which party would you vote for?

#### Trend in federal vote intentions: January 7-9


Q: If a federal election were held tomorrow, which party would you vote for?


#### Trend in federal vote intentions in Quebec

#### Trend in federal vote intentions in Ontario


Q: If a federal election were held tomorrow, which party would you vote for?






#### Vision for the future
