Ontario Budget Gets Thumbs Up


Methodology

- Telephone survey of the general public
 - ❖ 717 interviews with a national random sample of Ontarians 18 years of age and older
 - ✓ Interview period: May 13 May 17, 2005
 - ✓ National results valid within 3.7 percentage points, 19 times out of 20
 - The margin of error increases when the results are sub-divided
 - It should also be noted that the refusal rate and other measurement errors could also increase the margin of error
- All the data were statistically weighted to ensure the sample's regional, gender and age composition reflects that of the actual population of Ontario according to Census data.

The Ontario Budget

Majority recall budget

Q: The Ontario government tabled its annual budget on May 11, 2005. Would you say that you clearly recall, vaguely recall or do not recall hearing about it?



Q: Overall, how would you rate the budget?



Q: What do you think will be the **overall** impact of this budget for you and your family?





Provincial voting intentions in Ontario


Q: If a provincial election were held tomorrow, which party would you vote for?



Will not vote 2.2%


Tracking provincial voting intentions in Ontario

Q: If a provincial election were held tomorrow, which party would you vote for?




Provincial voting intentions in Ontario: region

Q: If a provincial election were held tomorrow, which party would you vote for?




Provincial voting intentions in Ontario: gender and age
