## The Political Landscape in Canada:

Results of an EKOS Survey for the CBC

April 2009



### Methodology

This survey was conducted April 8-13, 2009 using EKOS' unique hybrid internet-telephone research panel, Prob*it*. This panel is randomly recruited from the general population, meaning that, the only way to be included in Prob*it* is through random selection. Unlike optin internet-only research panels, Prob*it* supports confidence intervals and error testing.


- In total, a random sample of 1,587 Canadians aged 18 and over responded to the survey.
- A sample of this size provides a margin of error of +/- 2.5 percentage points, 19 times out of 20. The margin of error increases when the results are sub-divided (i.e., error margins for sub-groups such as regions).
- All the data were statistically weighted to ensure the samples composition reflects that
  of the actual population of Canada according to Census data.



**Q.** All things considered, would you say that the Government of Canada is moving in the right direction or the wrong direction?




### Health of democracy in Canada

- **Q.** And compared to 20 years ago, would you say the health of democracy at the federal level in Canada is better, worse, or about the same?









### Current vote intention vs. past election results






#### Preferred date for next election







Q. Do you approve or disapprove of the way the following leaders are handling their jobs?






# Outlook on the Economy & the Global Economic Crisis



- **Q.** Which of the following best explains how your retirement plans have changed? Have you...










### Greed and incompetence at root of economic crisis

### Executive compensation seen as in need of reform



■ DK/NR ■ Low (1-3) ■ Moderate (4) ■ High (5-7)






## **Attitudes towards diversity**



### Role for diversity in building a more tolerant society








Too much diversity can weaken a society and it would be better if we all subscribed to the same values and culture








