Lowest in Quebec




Methodology

- Telephone surveys of the general public data collection during SARS crisis includes:
 - ❖ Week 1 (Apr. 8-10); 450 cases (M.E.: <u>+</u> 4.6%, 19 times out of 20)
 - ❖ Week 2 (Apr. 14-16); 450 cases (M.E.: <u>+</u> 4.6%, 19 times out of 20)
 - ♦ Week 3 (Apr. 22-24); 453 cases (M.E.: <u>+</u> 4.6%, 19 times out of 20)
- The margins of error increase when the results are sub-divided. It should also be noted that the refusal rate and other measurement errors could also increase the margin of error
- All the data were statistically weighted to ensure the sample's regional, gender and age composition reflects that of the actual population of Canada according to Census data.


SARS Awareness Up Slightly

"How familiar are you with the current health issues surrounding SARS?"




SARS Awareness Highest in Ontario, Lowest in Quebec

"How concerned are you about the possibility of you or your family contracting SARS?"







Concerns Over SARS Lower in Quebec

"How concerned are you about the possibility of you or your family contracting SARS?"



"Have you altered your behaviour or plans in any way because of these concerns?" [Filter: those "concerned" about contracting SARS]







Behavioural Change Lower in Quebec
