B [ALTERNATE WITH A – HALF-SAMPLE EACH] First, all things considered, would you say the Government of Canada is moving in the right direction or the wrong direction?

Press 1 for Right direction..... 1
 Or 2 for Wrong direction..... 2
 [SKIP]..... 0

2. If a federal election were held tomorrow, which party would you vote for?

Press 1 for the Liberal Party..... 1
 2 for the Conservative Party..... 2
 3 for the New Democratic Party 3
 4 for the Green Party..... 4
 [QUEBEC ONLY] 5 for the Bloc Québécois 5
 6 for Another party not listed here 6
 7 if you are Undecided 7
 Or 8 if you are Not eligible to vote 8
 [SKIP]..... 0

3. [IF Q2=7] Even if you do not have a firm idea, are you leaning towards a party?

Press 1 for Yes 1
 Or 2 for No 2
 [SKIP]..... 0

4. [IF Q3=1] As it stands, towards which party are you leaning?

Press 1 for the Liberal Party.....	1
2 for the Conservative Party.....	2
3 for the New Democratic Party	3
4 for the Green Party.....	4
[QUEBEC ONLY] 5 for the Bloc Québécois	5
6 for Another party not listed here	6
or 7 if you are Undecided	7

5. [HALF-SAMPLE] Do you agree or disagree with the following statement: I think that there should be a strict ban on guns in urban areas.

Press 1 for Agree	1

6. Would you describe you and your household as poor, working class, middle class, or upper class?

8. [IF EITHER GROUP C OR D] Press 1 if you are under 35 years of age, 2 if you are between 35 and 49, 3 if you are between 50 and 64, or 4 if you are 65 years of age or older.

[Under 35 years of age] 1
 [35-49] 2
 [50-64] 3
 [65 years of age or older] 4
 [SKIP] 0

9. What is the highest level of education you have completed?

Press 1 for High school or less 1
 2 for College or CEGEP 2
 Or 3 for University 3
 [SKIP] 0

10. Which of the following best describes you?

Press 1 if you were Not born in Canada 1
 2 if you were Born in Canada, but at least one of your parents was not born
 in Canada 2
 Or 3 if Both you and your parents were born in Canada 3
 [SKIP] 0
