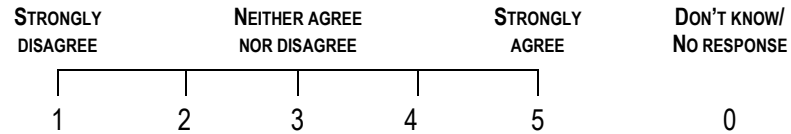

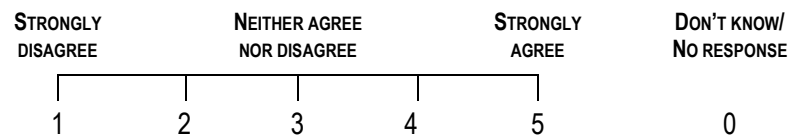
A Liberal-NDP agreement would lead to a more stable government.

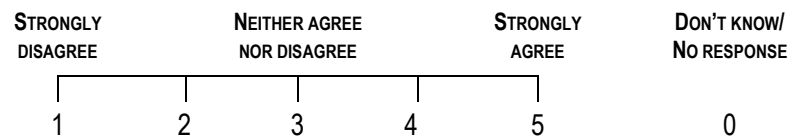

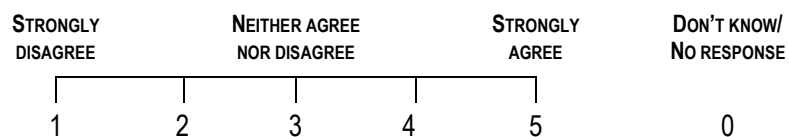
